Welcome to Atlanta

Atlanta is Georgia's largest city and the principal trade and [transportation](#) centre of the southeastern [United States](#). It is the centre of an extensive [metropolitan area](#) that includes 20 counties and cities such as [Decatur](#), [East Point](#), and [Marietta](#).

Atlanta owes its existence to the [railroads](#), the routes of which were determined by geography. Lying as it does at the southern extremity of the [Appalachian Mountains](#), it became the gateway through which most overland traffic had to pass between the southern [Atlantic Seaboard](#) and regions to the west. In 1837 a spot near what is now [Five Points](#), in the centre of the present-day city, was selected for the southern terminus of a railroad that was subsequently built northward to [Chattanooga](#), [Tennessee](#).

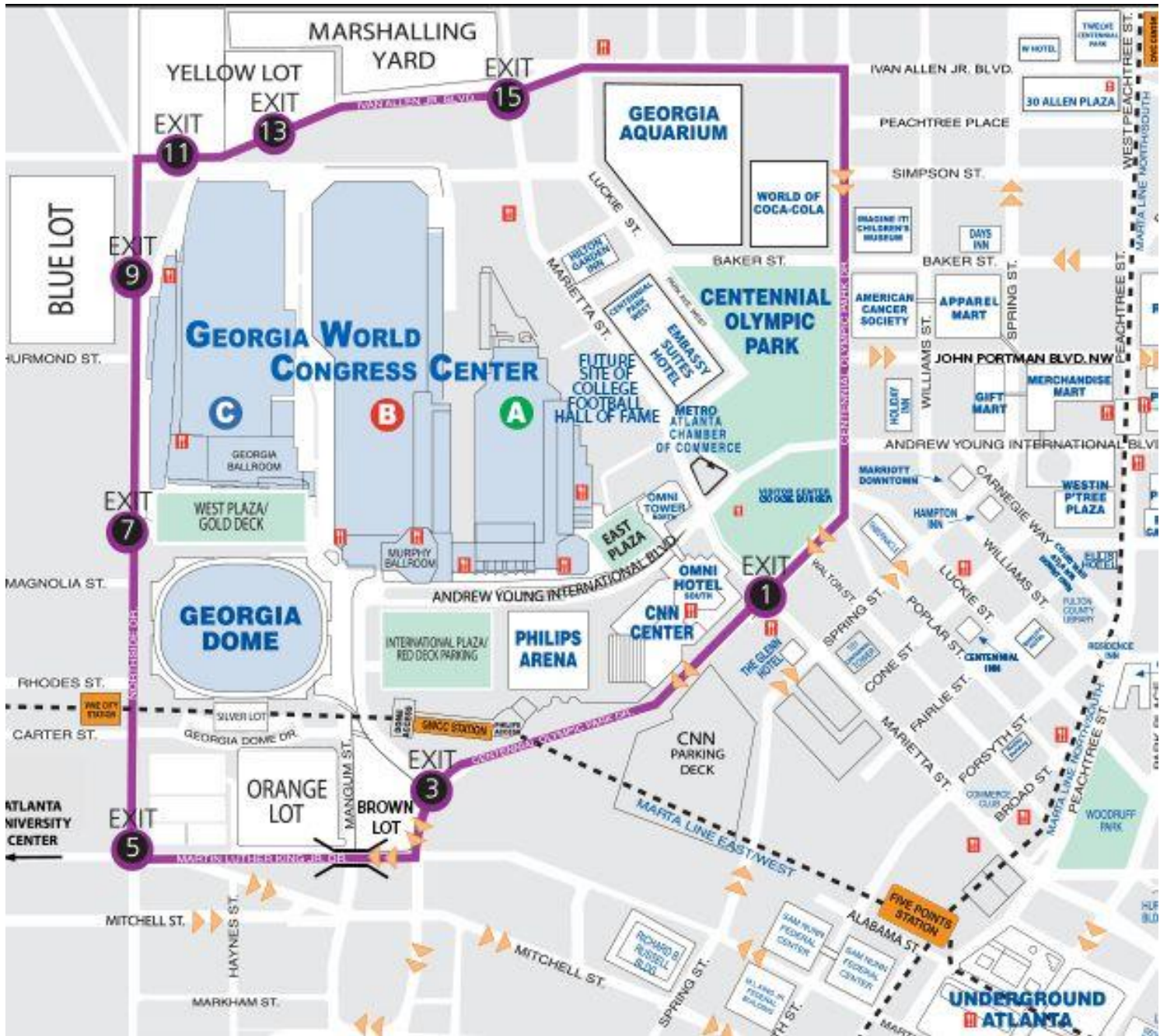
